Pembina owns and operates a strategically located pipeline network that serves various markets and basins across North America.


Facilities

Pembina owns and operates natural gas processing and Natural Gas Liquids fractionation facilities, export terminals, and related infrastructure.



As part of our approach, we continue to progress towards our GHG emissions intensity reduction target to reduce scope 1 and 2 GHG emissions intensity 30% by 2030, relative to a 2019 baseline (30 by 30).

Cedar LNG: Cedar LNG is a partnership between the Haisla Nation and Pembina Pipeline Corporation to develop a floating LNG facility in Kitimat, British Columbia, Canada, within the traditional territory of the Haisla Nation. Strategically positioned to leverage Canada's abundant natural gas supply and BC's LNG infrastructure, Cedar LNG will be powered by renewable electricity from BC Hydro, making it one of the lowest carbon intensity LNG facilities in the world.
